The river is followed by the Arniko Highway from Kathmandu to Lhasa beautiful mountain river, only a few hours from Kathmandu, offering and navigating Nepal's most challenging river rafting or kayaking trips at all classes of difficulty provide excitement, thrill and wilderness. Recommended for immediate and advanced rafter and kayaker.
